

CHINH DANG, CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER

Chinh Dang assumed the leadership role of Chief Administrative Officer of the Allen Institute in 2015 and leads the core administration functions including Human Resources, Legal, Facilities and Operations, and Information Technology. She has been with the Allen Institute since 2004 and most recently was the Chief Technology Officer leading the efforts on developing scalable and robust database management infrastructure, automated data processing, and data presentation and visualization of the publicly available Allen Brain Atlas resources. Dang started working as a molecular biologist at Colorado startup biotech company NeXstar Pharmaceuticals, which was later acquired by Gilead Sciences, before moving into the bioinformatics field. At Informax, a bioinformatics software company which was later acquired by Invitrogen, she served in both pre- and post-sales capacities to provide bioinformatics and data management solutions to large pharmaceutical, biotech, and academic institutions. Most recently, she returned to Colorado-based biotech startup Replidyne, Inc. to lead their efforts in developing high-throughput data management infrastructures to support the company's proprietary drug discovery process. Dang holds a B.A. in biology from the University of Denver and a M.S. in information systems from the University of Colorado.
