Christof Koch joined the Allen Institute for Brain Science as Chief Scientific Officer in 2011. For the past 25 years, Koch has served on the faculty at the California Institute of Technology (Caltech), from his initial appointment as Assistant Professor, Division of Biology and Division of Engineering and Applied Sciences in 1986, to his most recent position as Lois and Victor Troendle Professor of Cognitive & Behavioral Biology. Koch has published extensively and has served as editor for several books on neural modeling and information processing. His writings and interests integrate theoretical, computational and experimental neuroscience. Koch's research addresses scientific questions using a widely multidisciplinary approach. He received his baccalaureate from the Lycée Descartes in Rabat, Morocco, his M.S. in physics from the University of Tübingen in Germany and his Ph.D. from the Max-Planck-Institut für Biologische Kybernetik, Tübingen.
